The copyright of submitted manuscripts belongs to each author, and authors will grant permission to JRS to publish their manuscripts in the Proceedings of the 16th ISCOPS. This does not prevent authors from submitting manuscripts with the same content to other academic journals. However, depending on the academic journal, a manuscript published as the Proceedings of 16th ISCOPS may be considered as having already been published and may be considered a duplicate submission. Please check with the publisher of each academic journal for details.

Formatting your paper

<u>Title</u>: The first line (on the first page) should be blank. The main title should be centered; use bold font and capital letters.

Author name(s) and affiliation(s): Author names and affiliations are to be centered beneath the title.

The full name is required, and last name should be capitalized. Affliction should follow on the next line. The affiliations include the names of the authors, business or academic affiliation, address, and e-mail address.

<u>Abstract</u>: Each paper should include a 100- to 200-words Abstract. It should be a summary and complete in itself. Acronyms and abbreviations are not permitted.

Nomenclature: Nomenclature, if any, should be beneath the abstract.

Main Text: The paper must include an introduction and conclusion(s).

<u>Figures</u>: Be careful that all color figures will be printed in black-and-white. Figures and tables must be inserted in the text (as close as possible to their first mention in the text, preferably at the top or bottom of the page) and may not follow the Reference section. When citing a figure in the text, use the abbreviation "Fig." except at the beginning of a sentence. The captions for figures are to be below the figures, and the captions for tables are to be over the tables.




Fig. 1 A caption goes here.
